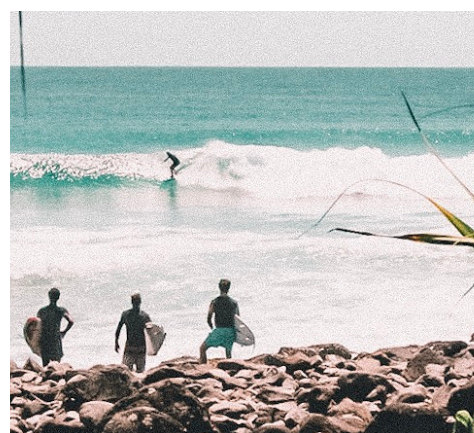


SWIM LAKE AINSWORTH TEA TREE LAKE

SURF THE POINT
