EAT THE COWRIE

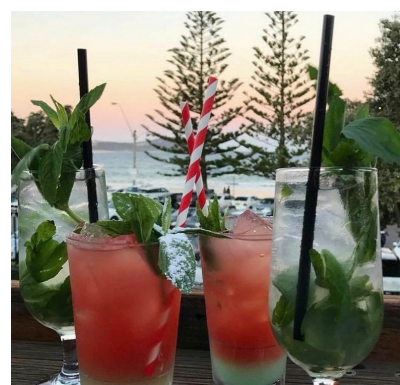

SWIM TERRIGAL BEACH

We love a swim where the water is calm and you don't have to battle the big surf to float on your back and chill. Terrigal Beach is unique because it is protected from the prevailing South East winds and so the surf is usually smaller than surrounding beaches. The town itself is a growing cosmopolitan hub and worth a visit, always bustling with visitors from all over and of course, the Cenny Coast locals!

SURF NORTH AVOCA

A swell magnet, NA can hold surf anywhere from 1 ft - 8ft plus. There are lots of left and rights available as the sand banks often shift, producing some fun waves. A bit rippy but still our pick over Avoca Point, which is far less consistent. Plus, the locals at NA are way hotter! (We may be a bit biased though).

SUNRISE THE SKILLION

The Skillion is a landmark lookout in Terrigal. It's about 100-150 metres above the water but only a quick walk up the stairs and well worth the sleepy morning effort. Seemingly never ending views extend both north and south. Watch the sun rise over the entire Central Coast and if you're lucky, you might even spot a whale or two!

SUNSET THE ROCKS AT AVOCA

The south end of Avoca is a beautiful little spot with rockpools, a grassy reserve and some mostly flat rocks that are safe to sit on when the surf isn't too big. It's a great place to take an esky and a picnic rug and watch the sun go down. If you'd rather a cocktail though, it's only a few steps to Surf House, a trendy upstairs cocktail bar situated right on the beach.

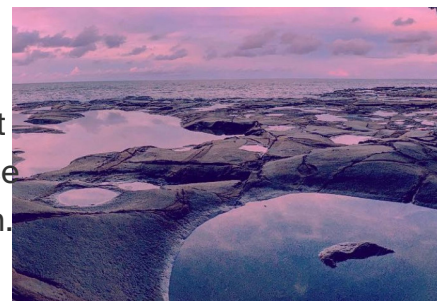
